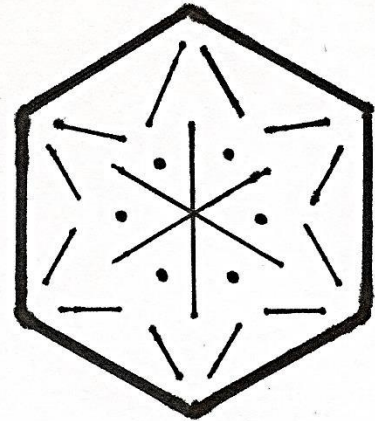
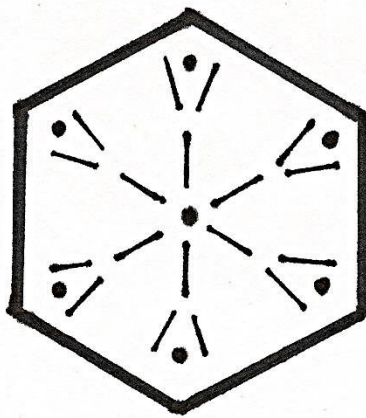


THE SNOW STORM Pin:



1. Cut out the hexagon shape in dark wool, acrylic felt, cardboard or paper. (You can go bigger or smaller. How big a Flake are you?)
2. Draw 6 legs out from the center. Or be brave and just start stitching with white thread or embroidery floss!
3. Add French-knots if you desire (the French have sometimes gotten a bad rap for being weak, but not here).
4. I kept this one simple. I didn't cover my mess in the back (It's small, that didn't seem to matter) and I didn't attach the safety pin with any stitches. I just used the pin to pin it on!
5. Learn some new embroidery stitches, or just play. You can't make a mistake. It takes very little investment in fabric and thread with the hope of big rewards.
6. Pin it on your coat or give it away. Make more. Watch them pile up. Create a SNOW STORM.
